### **ANSWER**

Reference here is to the Fatihah. The beginning verses of the Surah consist of praise for Allah, and the end is a supplication for guidance and this is for the servant. In the middle is lyyaaka na'budu wa iyyaaka nasta'een (You we worship and You we seek help from). Noticeably, the first part is for Allah and the second is for the slave.

### 3 WHAT IS THE REALITY OF TAWAKKUL?

### **ANSWER**

It involves full reliance and dependence on Allah. However this does not mean that the servant, the human being does not make efforts, does not plan or avoid danger, failure, etc. The prophet taught the man to tie his camel first and then have Tawakkul. Therefore, Tawakkul is submission to Allah in whatever happens after we did our part.
